

Cameroon Pesticide Training and Sampling

A Successful Capacity Building Project

Cardinal Resources Inc. (CDNL) working as a technical advisor to Pure Earth (Blacksmith) an NGO focused on environmental issues and clean-ups, recently completed training and field work related to former pesticide storage sites located in the agricultural areas of Cameroon.

Cameroon, known as the breadbasket of Central Africa has a long vibrant agricultural history. The objective of this project was two-fold; to train local Cameroonian teams in proper sampling and analysis and to assess a number of former pesticide storage sites. For Cardinal Resources, the importance of this work goes beyond the revenue generation. While still considered a developing country economically, the technical professionals of the country are highly motivated, well educated, hard-



working and driven to continue to improve the environment of their country as well as expand opportunities for everyone in Cameroon. Our participation in this work helps build global relationships and capacity in a key country for Cardinal Resources while working towards our mission of *Clean Water Clean Environment Worldwide*.

The work began in the Yaoundé, the capital city with classroom and field instruction covering the



environmental concerns related to pesticides and the approaches to site assessment of suspect sites. Participants in the training were from the Ministry of Agriculture, the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of the Environment. In addition to the training, laboratories for the analysis of samples were visited.

Moving from the classroom to the field, the group broke into two teams with Cardinal Resources working with the team tackling sites northwest of Yaoundé towards

the Cameroon Highlands and the cities of Wum and Bamenda. Working 7 days a week throughout the trip the team completed the data collection at multiple sites while continuing to train the local teams.

As many of these site had been abandoned or repurposed for other uses one of the first tasks for the team was meeting with local officials and landowners to determine the actual locations of the sites. As the site locations were determined the teams



went to work collecting soil samples for field and laboratory analysis.



Next steps on the project, which will be largely completed by the Cameroonians with technical support from Pure Earth and Cardinal Resources, is the entry of the information into a data base. From there the data can be assessed to determine the next steps for each site that can range from

no-action to full site remediation, another area where Cardinal Resources and Pure Earth can draw on their global experience in the clean-up of sites in challenging locations.
